It was followed by an orientation programme for all the students of final year B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. and B.C.A. Nearly 210 students had participated of which 57 were short listed & registered for this training. The same list was forwarded to Infosys BPO Ltd., Bangalore. Rigorous training in Analytical Skills was given by Prof. Mrs. M. S. Kulkarni and Prof. B. I. Vasulkar for nearly 50 hours. The training in Analytical Skill consisted of 1) Creativity 2) Lateral thinking 3) Brain storming 4) Puzzles 5) Brain Teasers & Problem solving using Pareto charts, Fish bone analysis, six thinking hats, decision tree analysis etc. Various problems on Numerical Ability, Test of reasoning were also discussed. Enough study material & home work was given regularly. The response of the participants was satisfactory. Tests were conducted regularly. Mock interviews & participants presentation were conducted. Finally some tips about the personal interview were also given to the participants. Training was also provided to the students in English Language Enhancement Skills by Prof. Mrs. S. S. Mutalik-Patil and Prof. Mrs. N.A. Jadhav. During this Training Programme, English grammar was taught to the students, to improve their language. The language skills were taught through various activities & games (Group & Individual) such as Ice breakers, Role-play, Quiz & brain storming games, fun games. Students were introduced to the English speech sounds in Phonetics, tongue twisters and effective Pronunciation Skills, to improve their English Pronunciation.

### 36) Placement Services provided to Students:

Activities of Placement Cell were formally inaugurated at the hands of Dr. D. G. Kulkarni, Co-ordinator of Centre for Foreign Studies and Placement Officer, Gogte Institute of Technology, Belgaum. He spoke on the etiquettes & manners required for better placement in corporate world.

Target groups from the final year classes were identified. Special training was given to the target groups by master trainers, who were trained by Infosys Cor. at Mysore.

Various Multinational Companies, viz, GENPACT, ASPIRE, W.N.S. ICICI PRUDENTIAL, TALENT UNION, TIME FIRST, METACAMPUS, conducted campus interviews in the college premises.

\* Our students were motivated to participate & compete for campus interviews held at other colleges by Infosys, Dell, Wipro, Cognizance, SATYAM COMPUTERS, Companies.

\* As many as 62 students have been offered placements at various companies with package ranging from Rs.12000/- to Rs. 21,000 p.m.

\* Local Companies like Spardana Office Systems, ESOFTZONE Technologies, ICICI Bank, Divigi Warner Pvt. Ltd., TATA Indicom, have approached the office for suitable manpower.

List of passed out students with their address is prepared and is being sent to the employers on request that helps the students to get placement.
